COMPLETING THE REGISTRATION PROCESS

To complete the registration process **please complete and return the enclosed paperwork to Audubon Vermont on or before June 1, 2009.** The information requested on these forms is needed to provide a fun and safe summer camp experience for everyone involved.

Your child will not be permitted to attend camp without this paperwork.

Please note that the Health Form requires a physician's signature! Thank you.

GENERAL INFORMATION

You will receive a letter from the Director a week prior to your child's camp session. It will explain the particulars of that session and will give any special instructions concerning what to bring for the week's events. In general, all campers can plan on bringing the following items to Ecology Day Camp:

A **snack and drink** for each day

A **bag lunch** for each day

A personal "**Gear Box**" - Sturdy container with a lid which will stay at camp all week. The gear box must be large enough to hold the following items:

A **backpack** large enough to hold a lunch, a water bottle and rain gear

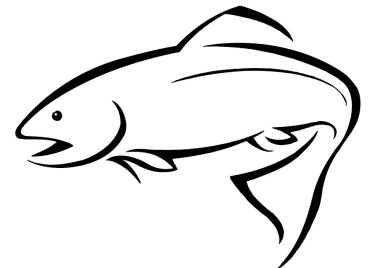
A **water bottle**

Hiking boots or **sturdy walking shoes** (please no open toed sandals or slip-on footwear)

Sunscreen and **insect repellent** (lotion is preferred)

Rain gear—a jacket, rubber boots and hat

One complete change of clothing including underwear, socks and shoes

NOTE: The Richmond Bridge will be closed until July 4th, 2009.

FROM INTERSTATE 89:

Interstate 89 to Exit 11 (Richmond).

Take Route 2 east, two miles into Richmond.

Turn right at the traffic light (Bridge Street).

Stay to the right at the Old Round Church.

Go approximately 5.0 miles, following the signs for Huntington.

You will drive over a bridge.

Just after the bridge you will see a Huntington town sign and a Sugarhouse in a field.

The Audubon Center's **Sugarhouse Parking Area** is just past the Huntington sign and Sugarhouse, on the right.

An Ecology Day Camp staff person will be in the parking lot to greet you on the first day of camp.
