

#### PIXIES AND POTIONS July 22 - 26 Age 6 - 8

Audubon is a magical place to discover nature's most mysterious plants and animals. From poison ivy to plantain, we'll learn to tell hazard from helper and have lots of time for foraging, making magical concoctions, and building fairy houses too!
