

Frequently Asked Questions: Summer Camp Registration

1) How much will the prices go up on February 1st?

2) I am a member, do I need a special code to get the early bird registration?

- a. Answer: No. If you believe you are a member, go ahead and register Early Bird. Before we process your payment, we will check your membership status. If you are not a member, we will let you know and not process your registration.

3) Am I a member?

- a. Answer: a quick way to tell is if you got the most recent issue of [Audubon Magazine](#). Membership is generally good for 1 year.

5) My camper is just above or below the camp age cutoff. Can I still register them?

- a. Answer: That’s up to you the guardian! If you feel your camper can “swing” up or down in camps, you are welcome to sign them up. We often break into trail groups that reflect camper’s age, ability, and interests to accommodate for cases like this.

6) Do I need to send in health forms to come to camp?

- a. YES! Each child that comes to camp needs either a [signed health form](#) from a physician or a copy of a recent (within 1 year) physical examination form. You or your doctor can fax 802-434-4686 or mail (Attn: Emily Kaplita) the form to our office.

7) How do I apply for a camp scholarship?

- a. Answer: Fill out and send in the [scholarship application](#). It is best to do this early.

8) PNC options are different this year!

- a. Last year parents could chose a morning session, an afternoon session, or both to make it a full day. Unfortunately, we felt that this short-changed preschoolers who joined us in the afternoon and made it impossible to take full day campers on farther adventures away from the barn. This year parents have to choose either half-day or full day and they happen on different weeks.
- b. Please note that during half day weeks, campers do NOT have lunch on site.

9) We are offering aftercare this year!

- a. Parents may choose to add aftercare for additional childcare after camp. It is offered from 4-5pm and is an additional \$5/day. IF parents pick up their child late, we will charge an additional \$1/minute! (We are human too and understand that things happen that could cause you to be late. We reserve the right to charge this fee if caregivers arrive late more than once.)

You can register for aftercare when you sign up for camp. Just click the box(es) that corresponds to the option(s) you need. You can find this in the same registration section as camp donations and t-shirts.
