Ruby-throated Hummingbird	Held with <u>spiderwebs</u> or pine sap <u>lichen</u> on the outside and <u>dandelion</u> down	A bowl	On a branch, throughout 10-90 feet
Wood Thrush	Grasses, leaves lined with mud and rootlets	A bowl	Lower sapling branches
Baltimore Oriole	Woven from <u>hair</u> and <u>plant fibers</u>	A gourd	High up on fork of thin branches
Tree Swallow	Grass or pine needles, lined with feathers	A bowl	Dead tree cavities
Red-Eyed Vireo	Twigs, grasses, needles, bark strips and lichen Held by spiderwebs and lined with plant fibers and hair	A bowl	Between branches midstoy
