What Is Audubon's Forester Training and Endorsement Program?

This program empowers professional foresters to incorporate bird-friendly ecological silviculture into their practices. By partnering with us, you'll gain knowledge, tools, and recognition with which to lead the way in sustainable forestry and habitat conservation. You will also help Audubon better understand the impact of your work and guide us in shaping the future of ecological forest management practices, public attitudes, and statewide forest initiatives in Vermont and beyond.

How It Works

- 1. Attend the training and receive SAF credits-> two options:
 - 1) Watch 3 online videos, answering a question to each and providing a response to a mock management scenario (all links and details available on our website here).

 OR
 - 2) Attend a day-long training: email us to learn of the next in-person training near you.
- 2. Provide two example forest management plans incorporating learned principles
- 3. Stay connected:
 - Report to Audubon annually on the number of plans and acres managed.
 - Join our distribution list to periodically hear of program updates and about new research, resources and tools.
 - Attend an annual refresher training with Audubon and receive SAF credits.
